

Pharmacy Prescriptions

Effective Jan 1, 2023

Pharmacists will be able to offer prescriptions for:

- hay fever (allergic rhinitis);
- oral thrush (candida stomatitis);
- pink eye (conjunctivitis; bacterial, allergic and viral);
- dermatitis (atopic, eczema, allergic and contact)
- menstrual cramps (dysmenorrhea);
- acid reflux (gastroesophageal reflux disease (GERD));
- hemorrhoids.
- cold sores (herpes labialis).
- impetigo.
- insect bites and hives.
- tick bites (post-exposure prophylaxis to prevent Lyme disease).
- sprains and strains (musculoskeletal); and
- urinary tract infections (UTIs).
